Expanding ON24 opens Charlotte office

ON24 Inc., the webcasting and virtual events platform tailored for business use, has continued its recent expansion by opening an office in Charlotte, N.C., that will be largely dedicated to providing professional services.

The announcement of the San Francisco-company's new office, which has four people and is expected to house 20 employees by the end of 2011, follows the opening of outposts in Paris, France, and Hamburg, Germany, last month. In addition, ON24 has offices in New York, London and Singapore.

Also last month, ON24 hired its first chief financial officer, Drew Hamer, who previously held the same position at publicly traded **Keynote Systems Inc.** (NASDAQ: KEYN) of San Mateo.

Founded in 1998, ON24 has 225 employees. The company has been profitable the last four years, with revenue last year up 22 percent over 2008's revenue to between \$35 million and \$40 million.
